Troop 667 is a scout-led troop where the boys decide, lead, and participate in their trips, activities, and service projects. We are a medium-sized troop founded in 1988 (27 years ago) where a scout learns leadership responsibility immediately. Our troop has an active outdoor program of monthly camping trips and special events (rock climbing, canoeing, and backpacking). A troop member develops a community service spirit and learns to work together in a team environment. The troop has 59 Eagle Scouts. Over 73% of our Scouts advance at least one rank during the year and 15% advance 2 or more ranks!

III. Troop Meetings

The regular meeting day is Monday 7PM at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church. All faiths are welcome. Some Mondays are devoted to troop meetings and the last meeting of the month is the boy-led Patrol Leaders Council for Youth Troop Leaders.

Court of Honor Awards Ceremonies recognizing Scout's advancement and achievements are scheduled 3 times per year. All parents, grandparents and siblings are encouraged to attend.

IV. Troop Equipment & Supplies

When a Scout joins the troop he receives a troop neckerchief, troop number patch, green uniform epilates, and a troop T-shirt for free.

The troop supplies camping stoves, patrol boxes (cooking pots & utensils), patrol tables, lanterns, and coolers from our storage unit at St. Timothy's for camping trips.

The Scouts provide a uniform, personal gear, sleeping bag and pad, backpack or duffle bag, food, and camping essentials from the Scout handbook, and personal tent (or share with another Scout).

V. Finances & Fundraising

The troop has fundraising year round, but the major fundraiser is popcorn sales in Aug-Oct. Scouts are responsible for \$5 dues per month collected at Troop meetings or can pay it in one lump sum at the beginning of each Scouting year.
